SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Your submission should include two MS Word files. One file contains an anonymous abstract with 3-5 keywords, and a title of no more than 12 words. Abstracts submitted should be no more than 500 words in length, single space 12-point font(Times New Roman) and limited to two A4 pages with 1-inch or 2.54-cm margins on all sides. The other file should contain the title of your abstract and personal information of all presenters, including, name, form of address (i.e. Dr., Prof., Mr./Ms., or Miss), country of residence, academic affiliation, and e-mail address. The two separate files should be emailed to thekumelt.convention@gmail.com before June 30th.

To Present in-absentia

- The conference will have a virtual room that will allow you to share your project or experience with the whole community of teachers, students and researchers of the teaching-learning process of English. The possibility of virtual participation is provided for speakers who, due to distance or other justified reasons, cannot participate in person. Virtual speakers will be able to send their contributions in posters or videos of 5 to 7 minutes. Abstract and paper submissions have the same deadlines as other speakers. All registration fees must be covered inclusive of postal and handling charges for certificates.
- In the oral mode for virtual speakers, the presentation of paper and link to the video file is mandatory:
- Presentation of the video work:
 - MPEG or AVI format
 - Minimum resolution 720p
 - Maximum duration: 3-5 minutes.
 - Can be uploaded on Youtube and link can be shared on email.
- **Posters** will have a maximum size of 100 x 70 cm and must be sent in PDF and can be displayed.
