CONSUMER FORUM



The consumer forum conducts every year awareness meeting on consumer protection act for the students.

In the academic year 2014-15 **Dr.A.V.Kavitha**, Assistant Professor of Zoology is a Co-Ordinator of consumer forum and **Dr.P.Senthil Kumari**, Assistant Professor of Tamil is a staff-Incharge of this activity.

The consumer forum activities were followed

1. The “**Consumer forum Awareness**” meeting was convened on 06.02.2015 at Prayer Hall of our college. Advocate **R. Vishnupriya., B.A., B.L.**, acted as Chief Guest of this meeting and lectured about “**The Rules and Laws of Consumer**”. In this meeting 800 I year UG students and village formers were participated and benefited.
2. The inter department competition (Oratorical, Essay, Drawing and Poem writing) were conducted on 27.02.2015 among our all department students.
3. The second consumer forum meeting was convened on 17.03.2015 on the aspect of “**Health and Nutrition**” **Dr. Susithra, M.Sc., Ph.D.**, acted as Chief Guest and lectured about health and nutrition. In this meeting 600 UG students were participated and benefitted.

CO-OPERATIVE STORE



Two staff members have been given the additional responsibility of maintaining the co-operative stores. Membership amount of Rs. 1 /- is collected from all I UG and I PG students. The money is utilized for purchasing the basic requirements like stationeries, Sanitary napkins and books for the welfare of the students.

ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES



The College runs a special programme on **Environmental Studies** under Part V activity. Under this programme, 100 students who are enrolled every year participate in various activities like Essay / Oratorical / Drawing Competitions related to creation of environmental awareness. They also involve in Solid waste management through Vermiculture and take responsibility for maintaining the campus green and clean. From this academic year, Green Audit is being conducted by the Environmental Studies Co-coordinator.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)



The College has three NSS Units functioning under three effective programme officers. Besides regular activities, NSS conducts special camp every year. The regular activities consists of cleaning the college campus, the temple premises of the adopted villages, planting saplings both in the college premises and adopted villages, conducting competitions, awareness programmes on occasions like Ganthi Jayanthi, International AIDS day, Breast Milk Week, Osteoporosis Day, Women's Day, Cancer Awareness Day, World Literacy Day and NSS Day etc.

The sportsmen make use of the Multi-Gymnasium available in the campus, to keep them fit, healthy and energetic. A special coaching is provided to sports students by expert coaches.

- Attendance is given on those days along with **Special dietary requirements, sports uniform and materials**

- For the needy students sponsorships are arranged to take care of their studies.
