



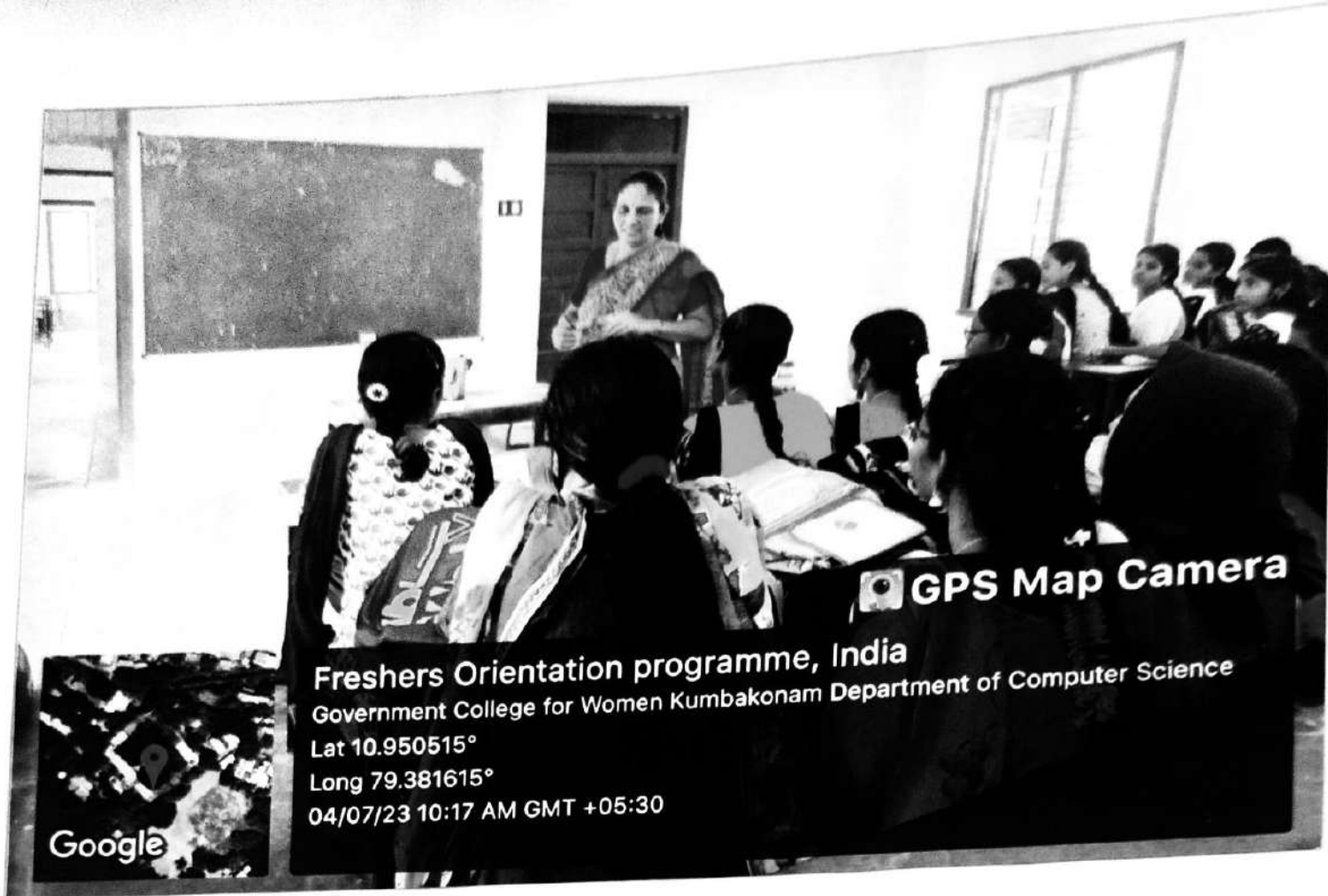
9. HEALTH AND HYGIENE

FEED BACK FOR FRESHER'S INDUCTION PROGRAMME

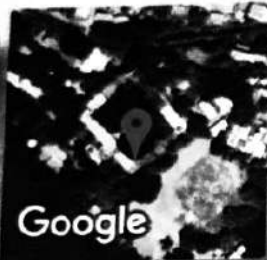
